





About Johnson C. Smith University

Founded in 1867 and located in Biddleville, the oldest surviving Black neighborhood in Charlotte, North Carolina, Johnson C. Smith University (JCSU) equips students to be global citizens who develop a compelling sense of social and civic responsibility for leadership and service.

Accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools (SACS), JCSU is the number one private HBCU in North Carolina.

JCSU connects Charlotte and the world to the next generation of bold innovators and leaders who are shaped by our strong traditions, vibrant campus spirit and thriving student-led atmosphere.

About Bro. Dr. Rufus Patterson Perry | Endowment

Dr. Rufus P. Perry, one of 17 charter members of the Alpha Omicron chapter of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Inc., was a prominent African American businessman and philanthropist who made significant contributions to education and civil rights in the United States.

In 1957, Dr. Perry returned to his alma-mater as the newly elected President of Johnson C. Smith University. During his tenure, he added \$7 million in new buildings, doubled student enrollment to 1,490 and increased faculty members from 55 to 120. An incredible fundraiser, Dr. Perry increased scholarships from \$50K in 1957 to \$800K in 1958.

Up until his death in 1984 at the age of 81, Dr. Perry was a strong advocate for education and believed that access to higher education was critical for social and economic mobility for African Americans. His legacy continues through the Rufus P. Perry Endowment, a fund designated to provide long-term support to Johnson C. Smith University.



About Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Inc.

and the Alpha Omicron Chapter

Alpha Phi Alpha[™], the first intercollegiate Greek-letter fraternity established for African American men, was founded on December 4, 1906[™] at Cornell University in Ithaca, New York by seven college men who recognized the need for a strong bond of brotherhood among African descendants in this country.



The fraternity initially served as a study and support group for minority students who faced racial prejudice, both educationally and socially, at Cornell. The Jewel founders and early leaders of the fraternity succeeded in laying a firm foundation for Alpha Phi Alpha's principles of scholarship, fellowship, good character, and the uplifting of humanity.

Alpha Phi Alpha chapters were established at other colleges and universities, many of them historically Black institutions, soon after the founding at Cornell. While continuing to stress academic excellence among its members, Alpha also recognized the need to help correct the educational, economic, political, and social injustices faced by African Americans.

Alpha Omicron Chapter

The Alpha Omicron (AO) Chapter of Alpha Phi Alpha was established on May 4, 1923 at Johnson C. Smith University in Charlotte, NC as the 36th Chapter of the Fraternity by 17 charter members. The College Brothers of AO administer the Fraternity's national programs and host other events sponsored by the chapter from the campus of JCSU. Alumni of Alpha Omicron Chapter are servant leaders in their fields and industries across the country.

Notable Members

Alpha Phi Alpha has long stood at the forefront of the African-American community's fight for civil rights through leaders such as W.E.B. DuBois, Adam Clayton Powell, Jr., Edward Brooke, Martin Luther King, Jr., Thurgood Marshall, Andrew Young, William Gray, Paul Robeson, and many others.

Since its founding on December 4, 1906™, Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Inc. has supplied voice and vision to the struggle of African Americans and people of color around the world.

The seven visionary founders, known as the "Jewels" of the fraternity are Henry Arthur Callis, Charles Henry Chapman, Eugene Kinckle Jones, George Biddle Kelley, Nathaniel Allison Murray, Robert Harold Ogle, and Vertner Woodson Tandy.
